 - 3.1 **Organisationsgodkännanden måste**, alltefter typen av verksamhet, utfärdas när följande villkor är uppfyllda:
 - b) <u>Organisationen</u> måste, alltefter vilken typ av verksamhet som bedrivs och organisationens storlek, införa och upprätthålla ett **ledningssystem** som säkerställer överensstämmelse med de grundläggande krav som fastställs i denna bilaga, hantera säkerhetsrisker <u>och</u> sträva efter en kontinuerlig förbättring av systemet.



CAMO.A.150 Findings

Regulation (EU) 2019/1383

- (a) After receipt of notification of findings according to point CAMO.B.350, the organisation shall:
 - (1) identify the **root cause** or **causes** of <u>and</u> **contributing factors** to the **non-compliance**;
 - (2) define a corrective action plan;
 - (3) demonstrate **corrective action** implementation to the satisfaction of the competent authority.
- (b) **Actions** referred to in points (a)(1), (a)(2) and (a)(3) **shall be performed within the period agreed** with that competent authority as defined in point CAMO.B.350.

ED Decision 2020/002/R

GENERAL

The <u>action plan</u> **defined** by the organisation should <u>address the</u> **effects** of the **non-compliance**, as well as its **root cause(s)** and **contributing factor(s)**.

Depending on the issues, the **action plan** should <u>address</u> **correction/containment** of the issue, **corrective action** and **preventive action**.




CAUSAL ANALYSIS

- (a) It is important that the analysis **does not primarily focus** on establishing **who** <u>or</u> **what** caused the **non-compliance**, <u>but on</u> **why** it was caused. Establishing the <u>root cause or causes</u> of a <u>non-compliance</u> often requires an overarching view of the events and circumstances that led to it, <u>to identify all</u> the <u>possible systemic and contributing factors</u> (regulatory, human factors (HF), organisational factors, technical, etc.) in addition to the direct factors.
- (b) A narrow focus on single events <u>or</u> failures, or the use of a simple, linear model, such as a fault tree, to identify the chain of events that led to the **non-compliance**, <u>may not properly reflect the complexity of the issue</u>, and therefore there is a risk that important factors that must be addressed in order to prevent a reoccurrence will be ignored.
 - **Such an inappropriate** or **partial causal analysis** often <u>leads to defining 'quick fixes'</u> that only address the symptoms of the **non-conformity**. A peer review of the results of the **causal analysis** may increase its reliability and objectivity.
- (c) A system description of the organisation that considers the organisational structures, processes and their interfaces, procedures, staff, equipment, facilities and the environment in which the organisation operates, will support both effective causal (reactive) and hazard (proactive) analyses.

(c) Internal investigation

- (1) In line with its just culture policy, the organisation should define how to investigate incidents such as errors or near misses, in order to understand not only what happened, but also how it happened, to prevent or reduce the probability and/or consequence of future recurrences (refer to AMC1 CAMO.A.202).
- (2) The scope of internal investigations should extend beyond the scope of the occurrences required to be reported to the competent authority in accordance with point CAMO.A.160, to include the reports referred to in CAMO.A.202(b).
