

## Consent to criminal records check for aviation security

You are eligible for a security clearance process which includes a criminal records check because you currently hold or have applied for a position with access to highly sensitive information or to security restricted areas.

### Information on criminal records checks

A criminal records check comprises information acquired pursuant to the Criminal Records Act (1998:620), Registers of Suspected Act (1998:621) or Police Data Act (2010:361). A records check also means acquired personal information processed by The Swedish Police Authority or The Swedish Security Service without being included in the aforementioned registers.

### I hereby consent to a criminal records check

A check of public records may not be carried out without your consent. You are therefore requested to give your consent by signing your name below. The consent also applies to renewed criminal records check as long as you are employed in this position.

For applicants under the age of 18, approval from the guardian is required for a register check to be carried out. In the case of joint custody, the certificate must be signed by both guardians.
