

The Swedish Transport Agency closes the case on Tesla

The Swedish Transport Agency will not temporarily prohibit the sale of Tesla in Sweden. The matter concerning a safety system in the model model S is now completed by the authority.

The media has stated that the Swedish Transport Agency is considering temporarily prohibiting the sale of Tesla in Sweden, as there has been concern that the vehicle has serious road safety deficiencies. As a Member State in the EU, Sweden may prohibit the sale of a vehicle for six months if such suspicions exist. However, it is not relevant.

"This is a case we have been following for three years and we are now finishing because we see the risk of accidents with the autopilot system being reduced," says Anders Gunneriusson, senior advisor at the Swedish Transport Agency.
