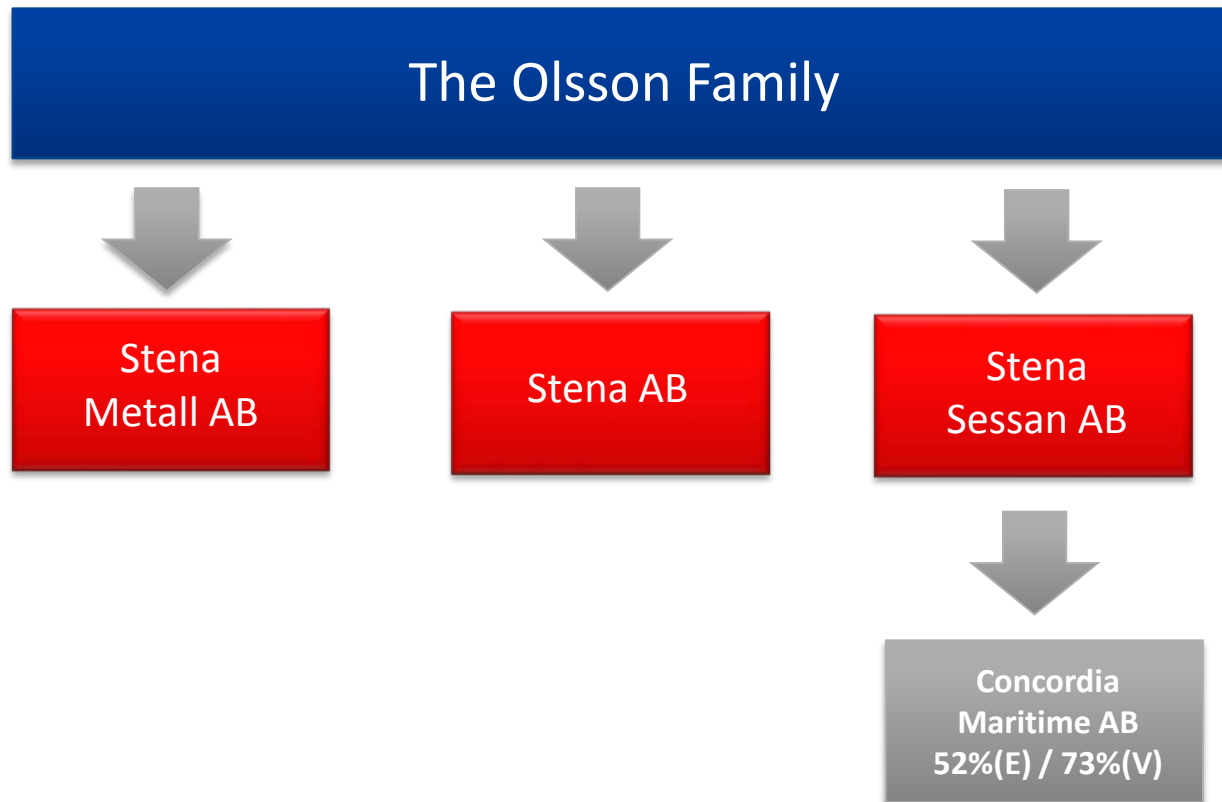

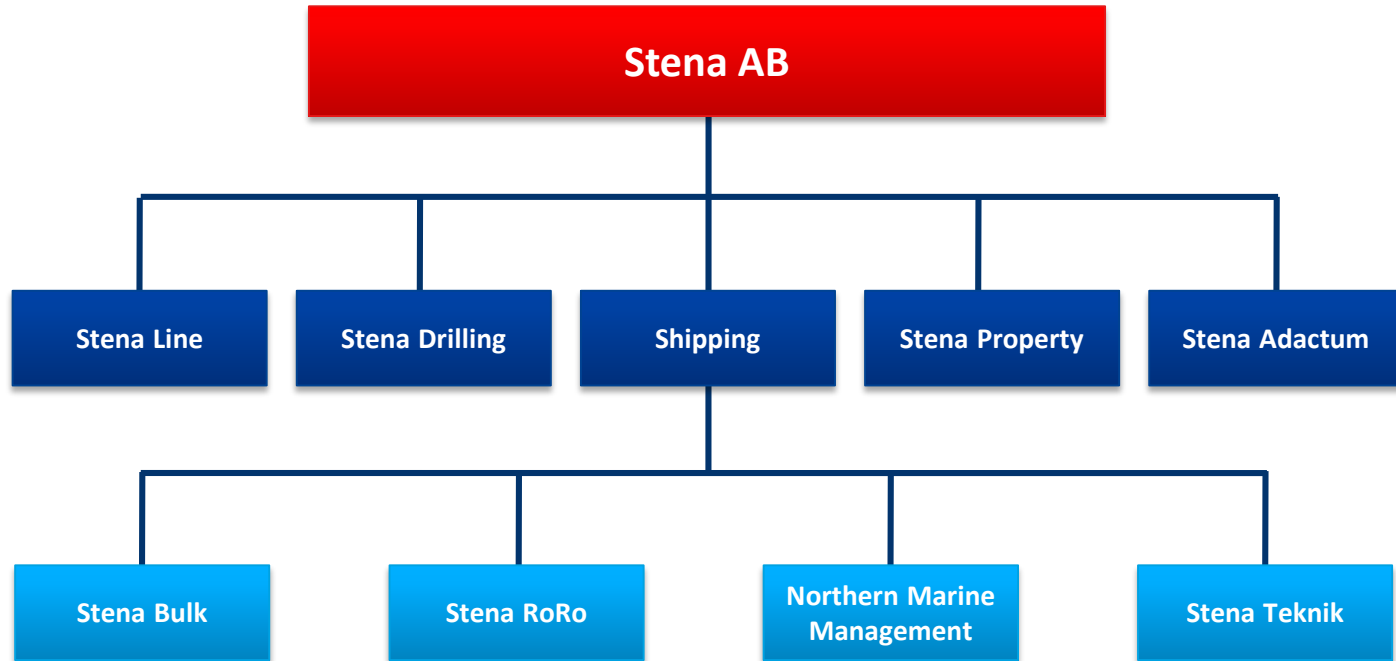

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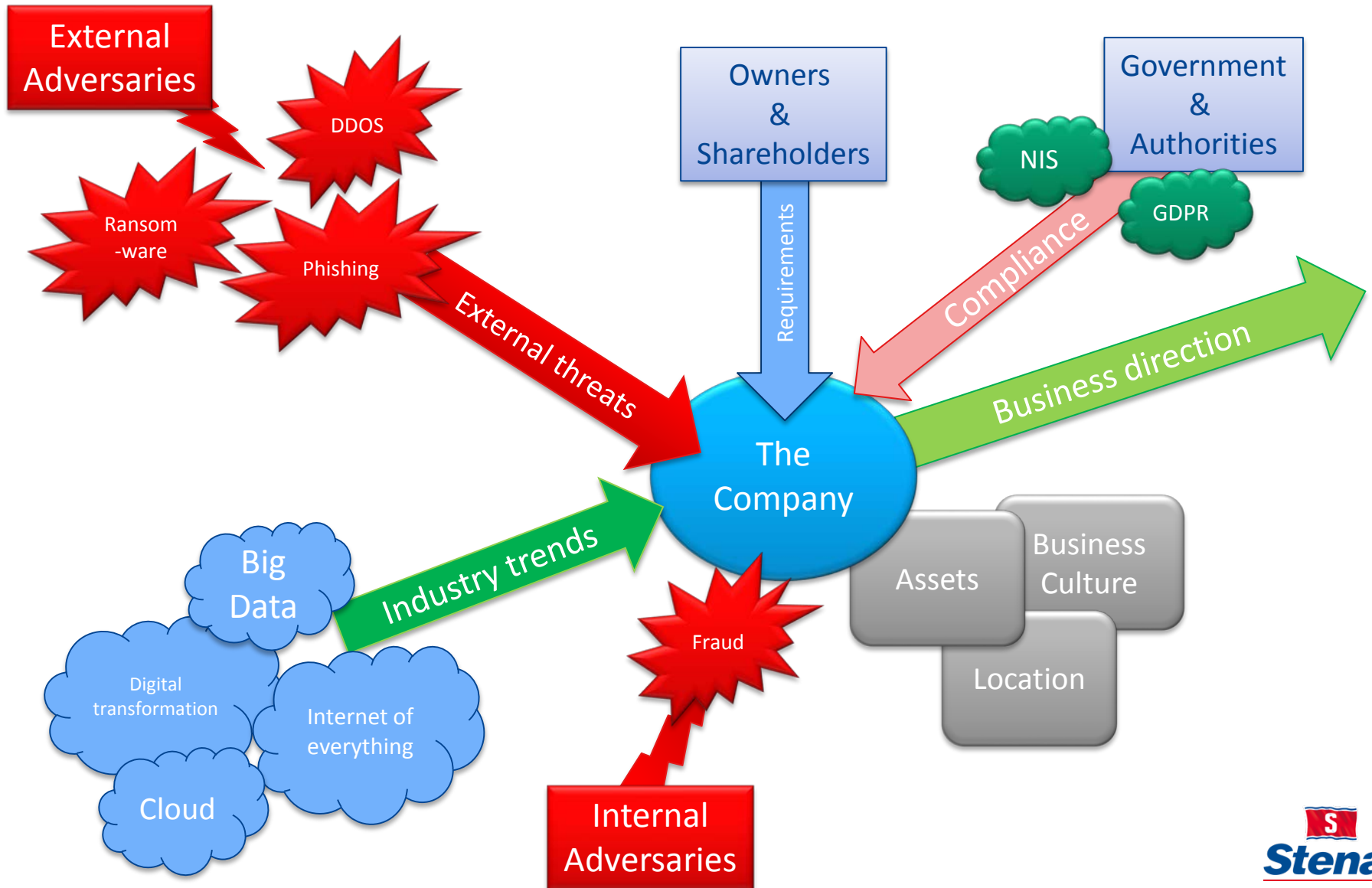
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The complex world of Information Security



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A Common Framework is Key

- Vast amount of areas to cover: encryption, application security, disaster recovery, compliance and much more – hard to see it all.
- No need to reinvent the wheel
- Achieve compliance
- In an interconnected world security is never stronger than the weakest link of the chain...
- The answer to your security challenges is a holistic approach – and you can't control a global environment without a framework!

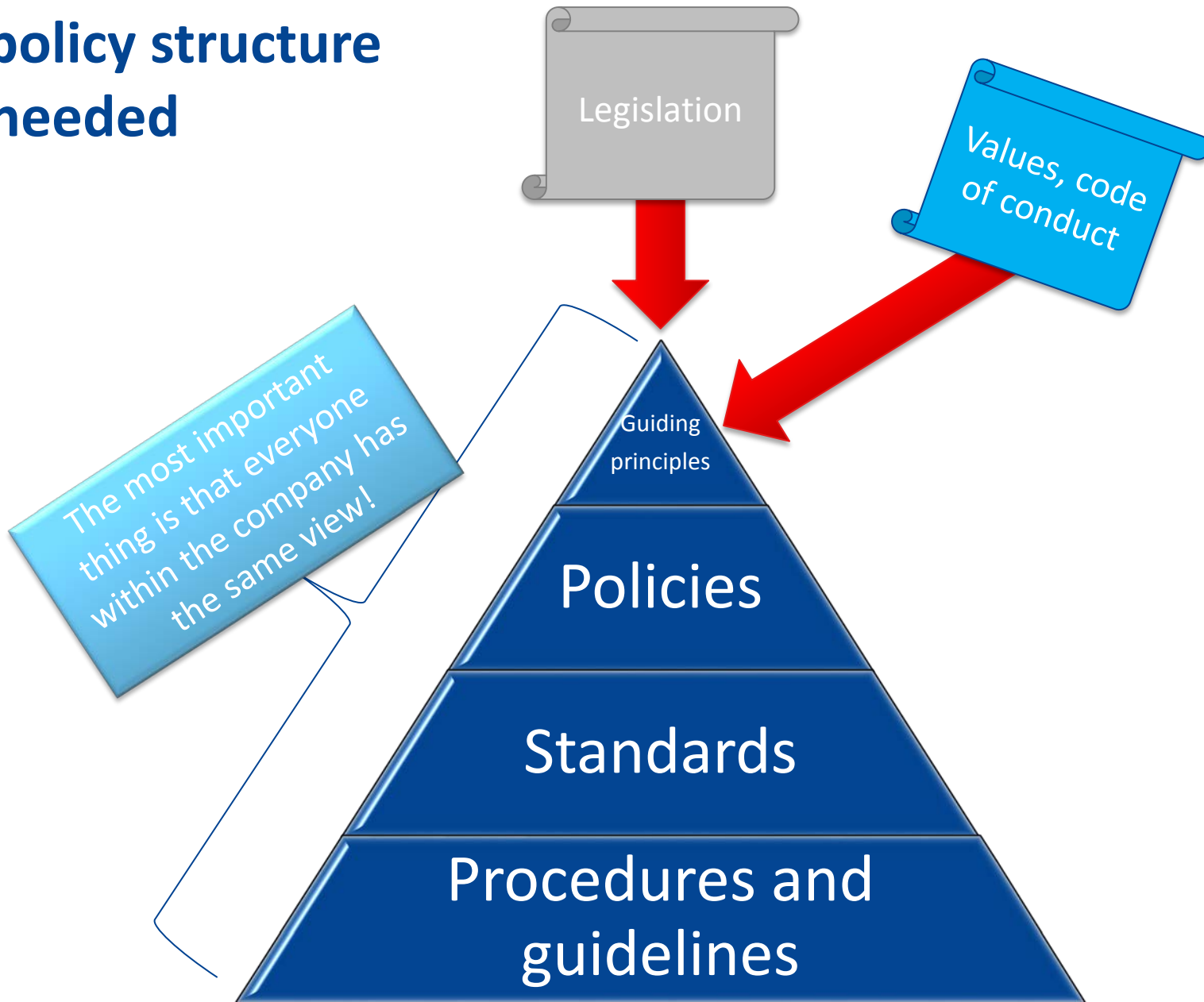

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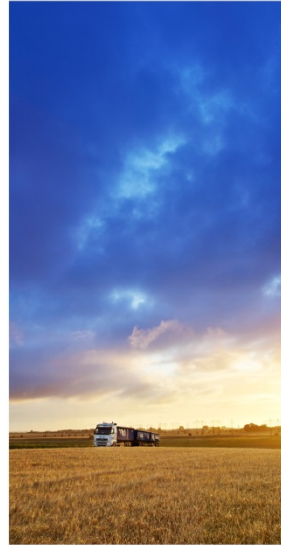
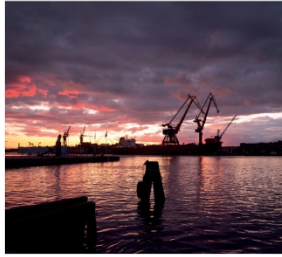
